<u>Call to serve as Executive Director at Valley Lutheran High School in Saginaw, Ml.</u>
Dear Parents.

I wanted to share with you that I have received a divine call to serve as Executive Director at Valley Lutheran High School in Saginaw, MI. I received notification on March 3, but the official call papers arrived March 7. Here is what that means:

I now have two divine calls for which to discern God's leading. One call is to Trinity Lutheran Church and School; one is to Valley Lutheran High School. The call process works much like a job offer in the "real world." The difference is that usually people seek a new job, but the call process works where the church or school seeks the person. I did not seek or pursue this position. Valley Lutheran contacted me via email back in January to notify me that they were considering me for this position. From there, a process began that brought them to prayerfully decide to issue me a call. I will now begin a process of seeking God's leading for where He wants me to serve Him at this time.

Please understand that this is not an easy task, nor it is fun. Instead, it is a prayerful discernment of God's leading in ministry. It is a very different thing than a job offer, and I will be considering both calls very seriously in the days ahead.
